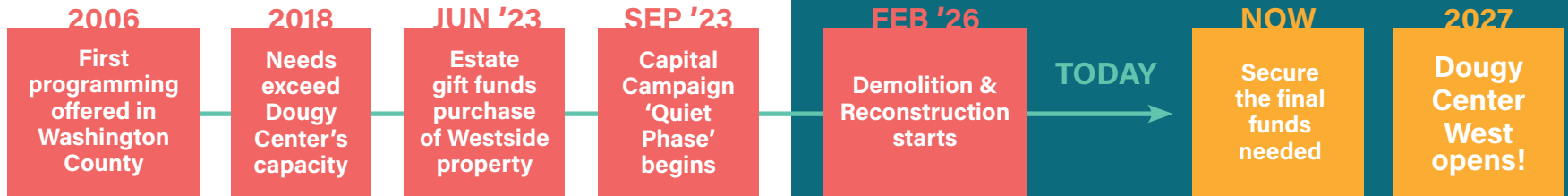

# Grief can be lonely, but you don't have to be **alone**.

Childhood bereavement is a critical public health issue and an increasingly important national priority. The death of a parent, sibling, or other important person in a child's life is one of the most frequently reported disruptive childhood experiences and without support, can lead to adverse health and welfare outcomes.

The demand for Dougy Center's services has never been greater. With our team answering **25,000 calls** every year, the waitlist for in-person peer grief support still averages **over 200 kids** who may wait as long as a year for direct services. **With YOUR help Dougy Center West will help even more.**



Renovations for Dougy Center West are already underway. The new 14,000 SF facility will feature indoor and outdoor play areas, spaces to gather and share, and a variety of intentionally designed expression rooms that allow children to explore positive ways to express their grief.
